TASTING NOTES: The Granite Hill Petite Sirah is a deep dark purple color with aromas of cherries and blueberries. The flavor is of plums and a warm berry pie followed by sweet vanilla oak that finishes with some soft and slightly spicy tannins.

VITICULTURE: Lodi has been a famed region for growing Zinfandel grapes for many years, but it has been the last 10-15 years that they are shining through with other varieties, including Petite Sirah. The sub-AVAs for this wine come from Sloughhouse and Alta Mesa, which are located in the northern part of Lodi, just west of the Sierra Foothills.

VINIFICATION: After undergoing traditional fermentation methods, the Granite Hill Cellars Petite Sirah is aged for three months in new French oak barrels.

INTERESTING FACT: The Granite Hill label is adorned with the California Poppy, the Golden State's emblem that grows among the landscape in Lodi.

FAMILY: Granite Hill Cellars is brought to you by the Kautz Family of Lodi, California. The name comes from the rocky and "granite" terroir the family's vineyards grow on. The soft rolling hills, in conjunction with the Pacific Ocean Delta breezes make these vineyards ideal for grapes of distinction. Practicing sustainability for over 30 years, the family is committed to the longevity of their land and the environment around them.
